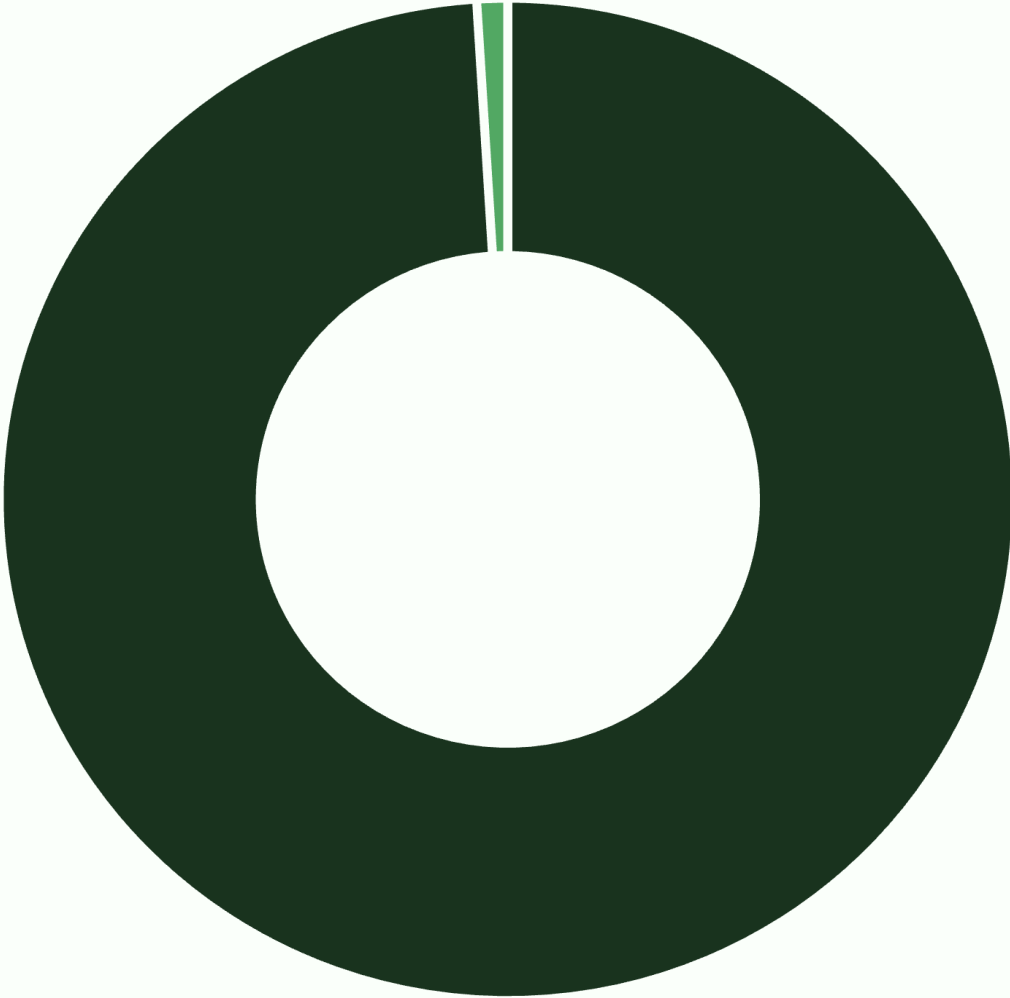


Block-wise Implementation Status

99.27% completion rate demonstrates exceptional implementation success with minimal balance remaining across the district.

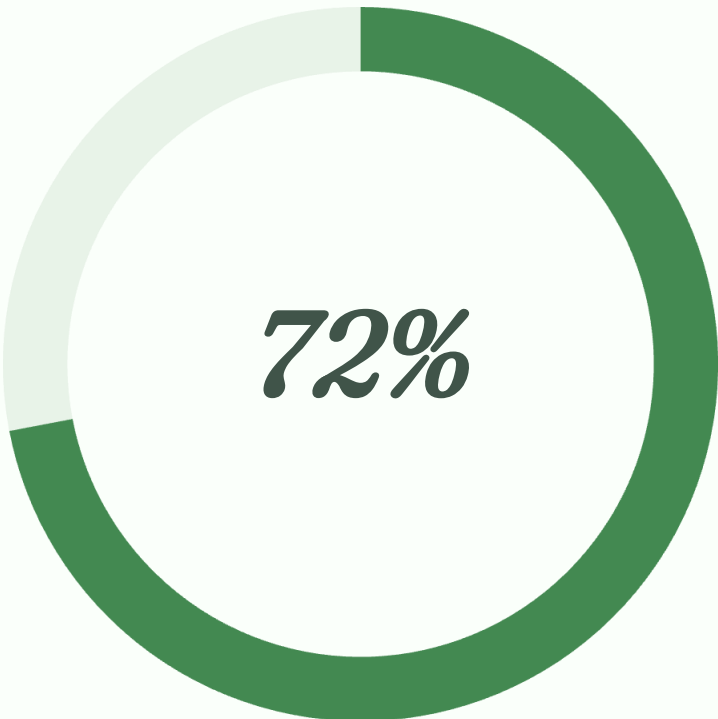

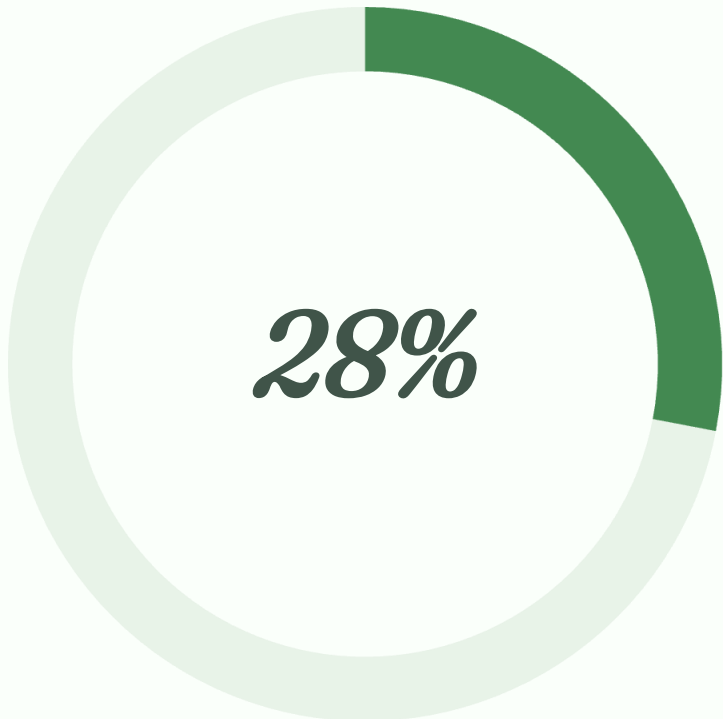

Solar Technology Solution

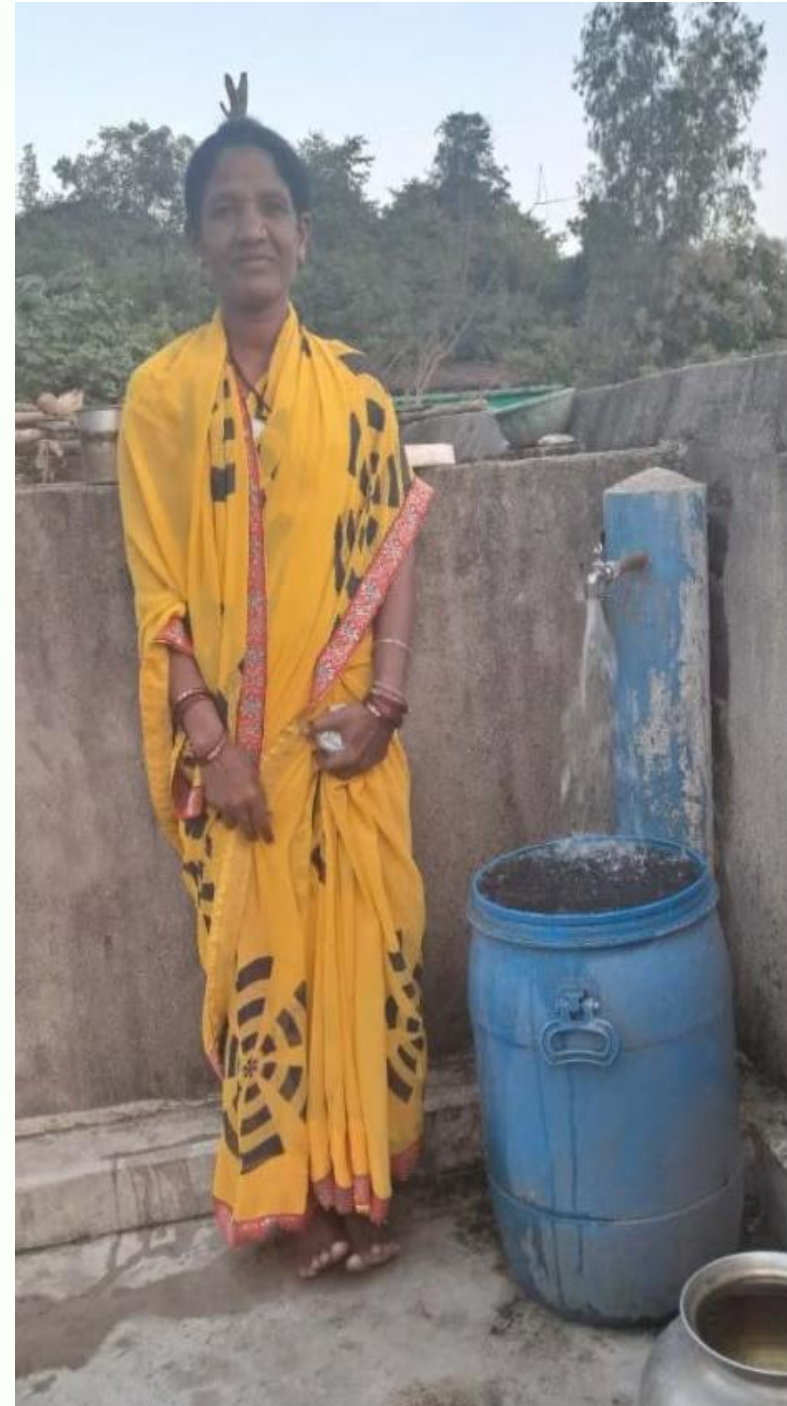
Jal Jeevan Mission implemented an innovative solar-based tap water supply system, providing sustainable and reliable water access using renewable energy.
